

SAFETY

- When drilling into brick work always wear safety goggles, a dust mask, and always work in a well ventilated area.
- Keep children clear of work area especially when assembling or moving the surround / mantle assembly.
- Always read the installer and owner guide supplied with the heater. This
 guide should be read in conjunction with those supplied with the heater.
- Always tidy loose electrical leads in the work area.
- Always switch off electric power when not needed.
- The surround / mantle must always be fixed into position.

HANDLING AND UNPACKING

Before continuing any further with the installation of this surround / mantle and hearth please read the following:

Important instructions.

• The approximate lifting weights of the surround / mantle and hearth are as below:

Surround / Mantle	18 kg.
Surround brace	0.5 kg.
Hearth	11.77 kg.
Back panel sides	2.63 kg.each
Back panel top	7.24 kg.

- One person should be sufficient to lift the Hearth. The Mantle / Surround and Back Panel assembly is heavy and we recommend that two people lift it. If for any reason the weight of either is considered too heavy then obtain assistance.
- When lifting always keep your back straight. Bend your legs and not your back.
- Avoid twisting at the waist. It is better to reposition your feet.
- Avoid upper body / top heavy bending. Always bend from the knees rather than the waist. Do not lean forward or sideways whilst handling.
- Always grip with the palm of the hand. Do not use the tips of fingers for support.
- Always keep the Surround / Mantle and Hearth as close to the body as possible. This will minimise the cantilever action.
- Use gloves to provide additional grip.
- Always use assistance if required.

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


Figure 1. Contents (Items are not to scale. Any components extra to those above can be discarded).

ASSEMBLING THE SURROUND AND HEARTH

The installation of this Surround / Mantle and Marble Set requires a reasonable level of DIY skills.

Please read this guide thoroughly before commencing installation and if in doubt, seek help from a competent person

Do I need any tools?


You will need the following tools:

- A Pozidrive / Phillips / cross head screwdriver. This should have a number 2 size tip.
- If drilling into brick work you will need a power drill (preferably with hammer action) and appropriate size drill bit for the wall plugs supplied.

How to assemble the Surround / Mantle and Hearth.

Step 1

• Place wall fixing brackets (C) 50mm from the top outside edge of the legs as shown in figure 2. Ensure that the two fixing holes in the brackets are positioned in the centre of the outside edge of the leg. The wood may split if the fixing holes are not central. Secure in place using four screws (D).



Step 2

- Lay the hearth in position on the floor. Stand the surround (A) on top of the hearth. Position the surround so that it is central to the hearth and the rear of the surround legs are flush with the back of the hearth.
- Mark the positions of the bracket holes on the wall. Move the surround aside and drill suitable sized holes. Insert the wall plugs (E).

Note: The wall plugs are only suitable for brick or block walls. For timber framed walls covered in plaster board we recommend the use of heavy duty cavity fixings.

Step 3

- Lay the surround (A) face down onto a smooth, flat, clean surface.
- Unscrew and remove the surround brace (B). This is the board section at the base of the surround legs.
- Assemble the marble back panel as in the guide supplied. Please note that the brackets on the rear of the back panel should be located so that there is a 60mm gap from the outside edge of the back panel. This will ensure that the brackets do not come in contact with the support channels on the rear of the surround.
- Slide the assembled marble back panel face down into the slot at the rear of the surround.

Step 4

• Position the Surround and Back Panel into position and secure using two screws (F) as shown in figure 1.

Step 5

- The heater supplied with the suite is intended to be secured in position using the 'Wire fix' method.
- It is not necessary to use the spacer frame supplied with the heater.
