
INTRODUCTION

The Stand-off Kit is a separately supplied pack to facilitate upward routing of the system flow and return pipework between the back of the above boilers and the wall.

This kit provides CH and gas pipes to fit behind the boiler. It also includes an electrical cross bonding bracket for equipotential bonding

2 PREPARATION

Prepare the boiler for installation, according to the Installation & Servicing Instructions.

Note.


If the side flue installation is being used particular attention should be given to the Installation & Servicing Instructions and the wall mounting template to ensure the flue hole is correctly located.

3 INSTALLATION


- 1. Use the wall mounting template to determine the correct positioning of the boiler and stand-off frame.
- 2. Drill three holes for fastening the stand-off frame as instructed on the template.
- 3. Insert wall plugs provided.
- Screw the stand-off frame to the wall, using the screws provided.
- 5. Secure the boiler wall mounting plate to the stand-off frame using the 2 M6 screws.
- **6.** Loosely fit clamp cross bond to pipe support bracket using the 4 M5x16 screws provided.

- Mount the boiler to the wall plate in accordance with the Installation & Servicing Instructions.
- 8. Discard all copper pipe tail hardware supplied in the boilers hardware pack. When doing this take care to retain ball valves, seals and pipe nuts.
- Fit isolating ball valves to the boiler in accordance with the Installation & Servicing Instructions ensuring all sealing washers are correctly placed.
- **10.** When valves are fitted and secured, tighten the 4 screws securing the cross bond.

Note. It is advised that the clamp cross bonding is checked by a qualified electrician. See Frame 4.

5 FINALLY

- 1. Go to Flue Outlet section in the Installation and Servicing manual.
- 2. Complete the installation and commissioning of the boiler, according to the Installation & Servicing manual.
