

# **INSTALLATION GUIDE FOR SPACER FRAME**


#### **Contents required: -**


1 Spacer Frame
4 Self-adhesive rubber pads
1 Nylon Grommets
2 Wall plugs
2 Wall fixing Screws
4 Self-tapping screws

This spacer frame is for use during installation where a chimney recess or rebated fire surround are not available. For your safety the frame and heater must be securely fixed to the rear wall.

### **Installing the Spacer Frame**

- 1. Fit the four self adhesive rubber pads to the rear of the spacer frame. They should be located on the rear of the vertical legs as in figure 1.
- 2. Position the spacer frame against the wall. Ensure that the spacer frame is central to the fireplace.
- 3. The top rear flange of the spacer frame has two screw locations. Mark the positions of the two screw locations on the rear wall (See figure 2).
- **4.** Remove the spacer frame from the fireplace and place away from the work area.
- 5. Drill the screw locations using a no. 12 masonry drill bit.
- 6. Insert the two fibre wall plugs provided into the holes
- 7. Insert a screw into each hole and screw in until there is approximately 6mm of screw protruding from the wall.





# **OWNER'S GUIDE**

# **Preparing the Heater for Installation**

- Remove the decorative front 1. surround from the heater (Refer to the Installation and Owner's guide supplied with the heater).
- *2*. Using the four screws provided, fix the heater to the spacer frame.




Figure 3. Fitting the Nylon Grommet

- There is a supply cable slot on both *3*. sides of the spacer frame. It is located at the base. Decide which side to pass the supply cable through. The nylon grommet supplied has a slot along its length. Fit the grommet to the mains cable with the flange edge positioned away from the fire (See figure 3).

- Position the supply cable in the spacer frame slot *4*.
- Slide the nylon grommet along the supply cable towards the heater. When the **5.** grommet reaches the slot, push it into the slot up to its flange (See figure 3).

## **Fitting the Heater**

- Locate the spacer frame and heater over the screw heads ensuring a tight fit. If the 1. fit is loose, remove the spacer frame and heater from the wall. Tighten the wall screws slightly and reposition the spacer frame and heater.
- 2. Attach the decorative front surround as described in the Installation and Owner's Guide.

# **Cleaning**

The 'brushed stainless steel' spacer frame should be cleaned using a slightly damp cloth and then dry. If this does not work apply a very small amount of 'baby oil' to a lint free, non-abrasive cloth and wipe over the surface. Use a clean cloth to wipe off the oil.
