

## **SAFETY**

- When drilling into brick work always wear safety goggles, a dust mask, and always work in a well ventilated area.
- Keep children clear of work area.
- Always read the installer and owner guide supplied with the heater. This guide should be read in conjunction with those supplied with the heater.
- Always tidy loose electrical leads in the work area.
- Always switch off electric power when not needed.
- The surround must always be fixed into position.

## HANDLING AND UNPACKING

Before continuing any further with the installation of this surround please read the following:

#### Important instructions.

• The approximate lifting weight of the surround components is as below:

Legs 3.7 kg (Each). Fascia board 1.84 kg.

Top 4.0 kg.

- One person should be sufficient to lift the surround. If for any reason this weight is considered too heavy then obtain assistance.
- When lifting always keep your back straight. Bend your legs and not your back.
- Avoid twisting at the waist. It is better to reposition your feet.
- Avoid upper body / top heavy bending. Always bend from the knees rather than the waist. Do not lean forward or sideways whilst handling.
- Always grip with the palm of the hand. Do not use the tips of fingers for support.
- Always keep the surround as close to the body as possible. This will minimise the cantilever action.
- Use gloves to provide additional grip.
- Always use assistance if required.




Figure 1. Contents (Items are not to scale. Any components extra to those above can be discarded).

## FITTING THE SURROUND

The installation of this surround requires a reasonable level of DIY skills. Please read this guide thoroughly before commencing installation and if in doubt, seek help from a competent person.

### Do I need any tools?

You will need the following tools:

- A Pozidrive / Phillips / cross head screwdriver. This should have a number 2 size tip.
- If drilling into brick work you will need a power drill (preferably with hammer action) and appropriate size drill bit for the wall plugs supplied.

#### Step 1. How to assemble the surround.





Figure 2. Fixing the fascia to the surround legs.

Take the fascia (A) and locate it to legs (B) (See figure 2). The fascia board should be aligned with the inside edge of the inner leg strips. There are pilot holes in the legs. Secure the fascia board to the legs using four (G) screws.

## Step 2. How to fit the back panel brackets for installations with solo-pro back panel.

Locate the two support brackets (C) as in figure 3. Each bracket should push up against the inner side of the leg and its base should be aligned to the base of the surround leg. Secure in place using six (D) screws.




#### Step 3. The surround top.

• Take the surround top (E) and insert 2 wooden dowels (F) into the pre-drilled holes on the underside. Place the surround top (E) on top of the surround (See figure 4). Ensure that the dowels are located in the internal corners of legs (B) and that the

veneered edge is facing forward. Screw into place using four screws (K) into the pre-

drilled holes.



#### Step 4. Securing the surround assembly.

- Where applicable locate the hearth against the wall.
- Place the wall fixing brackets (H) 50mm from the top outside edge of the legs as shown in figure 5. Secure in place using two (D) screws (One in each bracket).
- Carefully move the surround assembly into place. Mark the positions of the bracket holes on the wall. Move the assembly aside and drill suitable sized holes. Insert the wall plugs (J).
- For installations using the solo-pro back panel and hearth only Assemble the solo-pro back panel as in the guide supplied with it ensuring that the overall width will fit into the surround assembly. Once assembled slide the back panel assembly between the rear of

the surround legs and the support brackets.

• Position the assembly and secure using two screws (K).

Note: The wall plugs are only suitable for brick or block walls. For timber framed walls covered in plaster board we recommend the use of heavy duty cavity fixings.

#### **Step 5. Fitting the heater.**

For full fitting instructions see the installer and owner guide supplied with the heater. Please note that where applicable we do not recommend screw fitting the heater to the Valor solo-pro back panel and hearth, but recommend the cable retention method instead.

#### Caring for your Surround.

- DO wipe any spills off immediately to limit possibility of staining.
- DO clean regularly with a soft damp cloth.
- DO NOT use abrasive cleaners.
- DO NOT allow prolonged exposure to water.
