

SAFETY

- Always wear gloves when handling the back panel.
- When drilling into brick work always wear safety goggles, a dust mask, and always work in a well ventilated area.
- Keep children clear of work area.
- Always read this guide in conjunction with the guides supplied with the heater / fire.
- Always tidy loose electrical leads in the work area.
- Always switch off electric power when not needed.
- The Durham, Camborne and Pacha surrounds must always be fixed into position.


HANDLING AND UNPACKING

Before continuing any further with the installation of this surround and hearth please read the following:

Important instructions.

- The approximate lifting weight of the surround and hearth assembly is 30.0 kg.
- This surround and hearth assembly is heavy. We therefore recommend that two
 people should be sufficient to lift the surround and hearth assembly. If fitting or
 moving the surround and hearth assembly alone we recommend the use of
 suitable lifting apparatus.
- When lifting always keep your back straight. Bend your legs and not your back.
- Avoid twisting at the waist. It is better to reposition your feet.
- Avoid upper body / top heavy bending. Always bend from the knees rather than the waist. Do not lean forward or sideways whilst handling.
- Always grip with the palm of the hand. Do not use the tips of fingers for support.
- Always keep the Surround or Hearth as close to the body as possible. This will minimise the cantilever action.
- Use gloves to provide additional grip.
- Always use assistance if required.

FITTING THE SURROUND / MANTLE AND HEARTH

The installation of this Surround and Hearth requires a reasonable level of DIY skills. Please read this guide thoroughly before commencing installation and if in doubt, seek help from a competent person

Do I need any tools?

You will need the following tools:

- A Pozidrive / Phillips / cross head screwdriver. This should have a number 2 size tip.
- If drilling into brick work you will need a power drill (preferably with hammer action) and suitably sized drill bit for the wall plugs supplied.

The Durham Surround.

The Durham surround is supplied ready for use with an electric fire. If it is to be used for installations with a gas fire then the inner gas rails will have to be fitted. Do this as below:

- Unscrew and remove the Back Panel.
- Unscrew and remove the two lower back panel supports from the hearth.





Figure 2. Gas rail positions as supplied.

- The gas rails are supplied fitted to the rear of the surround (See figure 2). They are screwed and are adjacent to their required locations. Unscrew and remove one rail at a time. We recommend that the top rail is fitted last. Locate and screw the rails in place using the screws previously removed (See figure 3).
- Replace the back panel using the screws removed previously.




Securing the Durham, Camborne and Pacha Surrounds.

• Place the wall fixing brackets 50mm from the top and bottom outside edge of the legs as shown in figure 4. Ensure that the two fixing holes in the brackets are

positioned in the centre of the outside edge of the leg. The surround may split if the fixing holes are not central. Secure in place using eight screws.

 Position the Hearth and surround assembly in place. Mark the positions of the bracket holes on the wall. Move the



assembly aside and drill suitable sized holes. Insert wall plugs. Position the whole assembly into position and secure using four screws.

Note: Wall plugs are only suitable for brick or block walls. For timber framed walls covered in plaster board we recommend the use of heavy duty cavity fixings.
